The Rosary is a meditation on events in the lives of Jesus and our Blessed Mother. It is composed of four mysteries: the Joyful Mysteries, the Sorrowful Mysteries, the Luminous Mysteries and the Glorious Mysteries. To pray the Rosary, make the sign of the Cross on the crucifix, say the Apostles Creed. On each of the large beads, say the Our Father; and on the small beads, say the Hail Mary. The Glory Be is said after the three Hail Mary's at the beginning of the Rosary and after each decade of the Hail Mary's on the small beads. Conclude by saying the Hail Holy Queen.

The month of May is dedicated to Mary.

The recitation of the Rosary is especially encouraged during the



month of May. The Fatima statue of Mary in the parish has been passed from family to family to encourage the saying of the Rosary in families who take possession of it during any week.
