### THE ROSARY AND FATIMA

The Rosary is often misunderstood as a form of worshiping Mary. But, in fact, it is a biblical prayer that draws us closer to Christ and teaches us about His life. The Rosary prayers consist of the Apostles' Creed confirming belief in our faith; the Glory Be, praising the Holy Trinity; the Our Father, given to us by Christ himself; and the Hail Mary, the words coming primarily from the greetings to Mary by the Archangel Gabriel and by Mary's kinswoman, Elizabeth, as recorded in Scripture (Luke 1:28, 42). As we pray, we are encouraged to meditate on the mysteries of Jesus.

Some struggle with the repetitive nature of the Rosary but *this* is the source of its strength and power. When we say the Hail Mary repeatedly, our Prayers to Mary become like familiar, soothing music that paces us and sets our souls at ease.

While many people have a great devotion to Our Lady of Fatima, it seems as though the world is in nearly the same state now as it was when Mary appeared in Fatima.

We need to pray the Rosary, work to convert sinners, and continue to pray for peace. The message of Fatima is needed now more than ever. The 100th Anniversary is a reminder that all of us are called to this message of peace and prayer.
